AAHOA Statement on U.S. Chamber & IFA Report on the Joint Employer Standard

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Asian American Hotel Owners Association President and CEO Chip Rogers released the following statement regarding the [new report](#) issued by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and the International Franchise Association on the joint employer standard:

“This report shows in crystal clear and irrefutable terms that the expanded joint employer standard is already negatively impacting small businesses—the chief driver of new jobs in America—despite what proponents of the new standard claim. With our economy coming dangerously close to shrinking and new jobs being created at an anemic pace, Congress has an imperative to remedy the attacks on small businesses by the NLRB and DOL through the passage of the Protecting Local Business Opportunity Act introduced by Sen. Lamar Alexander (R-TN) and Rep. John Kline (R-MN).”
