Quick Facts

AAHOA and the University of Houston (UH) have established the AAHOA Assistantship and Scholarship Endowment¹ to help fund students of UH's Conrad N. Hilton College (CNHC). A total of **\$50,000** will be available per academic year.

Assistantship applicants:

- Are selected by the CNHC dean
- Must be in good standing with UH
- Must be currently registered in the CNHC
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Must show exceptional citizenship and leadership qualities
- Must demonstrate a strong career interest in the hospitality industry

Scholarship applicants²:

- Are selected by the CNHC Scholarship Committee
- Must be full-time students in good standing with UH
- Must be currently registered in the CNHC
- Must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Must show exceptional citizenship and leadership qualities (as determined by the committee)
- Must demonstrate a strong career interest in the hospitality industry

Out-of-state students who are selected for an AAHOA Scholarship will be automatically qualified for in-state tuition rates!
